Dear Senator:

The Fair Currency Coalition **urges the Senate to pass H.R. 2378**, the Currency Reform for Fair Trade Act, prior to adjourning *sine die*. This legislation passed the U.S. House of Representatives on September 29 by a strong bipartisan vote of 348 to 79. **The attached petition** from trade associations, agricultural groups, labor organizations, and individual companies also demonstrates the breadth and depth of our support across America.

The American people delivered a clear message in the 2010 election. They want quick bipartisan action to create more jobs, to reduce deficits, and to stop countries like China from weakening our economy by unlawful means like currency manipulation. The U.S. Senate can reply with an immediate “message understood” by passing H.R. 2378.

The G-20’s latest failure to take action with respect to China’s illegal currency undervaluation reinforces the need for the Senate to act promptly. The G-20 could only agree to study the problem for another year with no promise of definitive action thereafter. Meanwhile, millions of American jobs lost to subsidized Chinese competition have gone unrecovered, and the mountain of debt that America owes to foreign creditors continues to soar. American businesses, farmers, and workers cannot afford more delay. They need action now by the U.S. government to stop currency undervaluation.

As amended by the House Committee on Ways and Means and passed on the floor, H.R. 2378 tackles the currency problem in a pro-jobs, pro-growth, and pro-investment fashion. It clarifies the responsibility of the U.S. Department of Commerce to investigate alleged currency subsidies, to establish facts on a case-by-case basis, and to determine the existence and magnitude of the undervaluation using the same methods as the International Monetary Fund. H.R. 2378 also orders the Comptroller General of the United States to report on the legislation’s implementation nine months following enactment.

H.R. 2378 is remedial in nature. It is WTO-compliant and gives no grounds for retaliation by any trading partner. The bill is a targeted remedy that sends an across-the-board message. Enactment of the bill would have a positive impact on the U.S. economy without incurring any new public debt or significant budgetary expenditures.

The Fair Currency Coalition believes it is imperative that the Senate help Main Street America by counteracting currency undervaluation by China and any other country engaging in this mercantilist practice. The time for action is now. Pass H.R. 2378 prior to adjourning *sine die*.
